3) **Maintenance:**

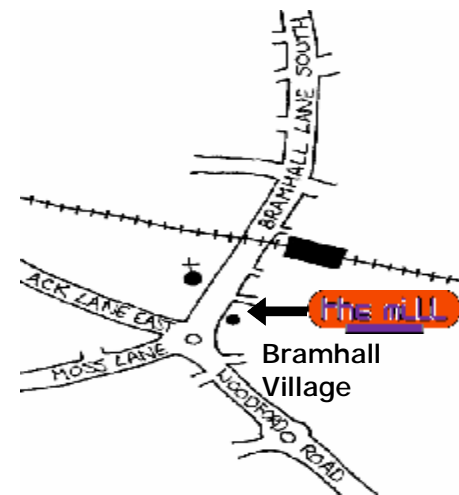
